R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of Andrews County are gathering in
2 Austin on February 4, 2025, to celebrate Andrews County Day at the
3 State Capitol; and

4 WHEREAS, Situated on the high plains of the Permian Basin,
5 Andrews County was established in 1876 and formally organized in
6 1910 with Andrews as its county seat; both the city and county are
7 named for Richard Andrews, an early settler and soldier in the
8 revolutionary army and the first man to die in the Texas War for
9 Independence in 1835; and

10 WHEREAS, Andrews County has long been a leader in the
11 ranching industry in Texas, and with widespread use of windmills,
12 it became an important source of cotton and sorghum; it experienced
13 an impressive oil boom during the 1940s and recently underwent the
14 greatest period of growth and development in its history; it
15 remains one of the state's leading producers of oil and gas; and

16 WHEREAS, With unprecedented support from citizens, public
17 officials, and civic organizations in the area, Andrews County
18 hosts the most advanced secure facility for the disposal of Class A,
19 B, and C low-level radioactive waste in the United States; and

20 WHEREAS, The Andrews Independent School District is highly
21 regarded, and its students have earned top honors at numerous
22 University Interscholastic League academic competitions; and

23 WHEREAS, The people of Andrews County enjoy an abundance of
24 recreational opportunities, including the Andrews County Golf

1 Course and many exemplary area parks; the county also boasts the
2 annual Wild, Wild West Fest, which celebrates the region's Western
3 heritage; and

4 WHEREAS, Honoring their history as they embrace the
5 opportunities of the future, the citizens of Andrews County may
6 take great pride in the role their community has played in the story
7 of the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the 89th Texas Legislature
9 hereby recognize February 4, 2025, as Andrews County Day at the
10 State Capitol and extend a warm welcome to the visiting delegation.
