R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, All who shared in the life of Alvin Henry
2 Boenker III were deeply saddened by his death on March 29, 2024, at
3 the age of 74; and

4 WHEREAS, A native of Fort Worth, Al Boenker was born on
5 October 7, 1949, and he attended Castleberry High School; he
6 married the love of his life, Sue, on December 5, 1970, and the
7 couple shared a fulfilling union that spanned five decades before
8 her passing; they became the proud parents of two children, Al and
9 Ashley, and later welcomed into their treasured family seven
10 grandchildren, Joellie, Oaklie, Quinlie, Cameron, Cole, Trigger,
11 and the late Al Boenker V; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Boenker established Al Boenker Insurance
13 Agency, Inc., in September 1972, and under his able leadership, the
14 business expanded to include a managing general agency and an
15 insurance company serving Texas; he also founded a corporation in
16 Mexico, and he supported his wife as she built one of the largest
17 Allstate agencies in the nation; in 2022, he stepped down from his
18 corporate responsibilities at ABI/Alinsco and took on the role of
19 chair emeritus; and

20 WHEREAS, A man of strong faith, Mr. Boenker enriched the
21 lives of others with his compassion, kindness, and spiritual
22 guidance, and during the holiday season, he shared the gospel on
23 major broadcast networks; and

24 WHEREAS, Al Boenker lived a life that was rich in personal and

1 professional achievements, and he will forever be a source of
2 inspiration to those he leaves behind; now, therefore, be it

4 hereby pay tribute to the memory of Alvin Henry Boenker III and
