6 companionship of a brother, Trey; while attending Texas A&M

9 union that spanned three decades; and

11 worked for an architectural firm before joining his family's air
12 conditioning business, where he served as general manager for more
13 than 20 years; in 2016, he and his wife purchased a local printing
14 company, AlphaGraphics, which they built into a successful
15 business; and

16 WHEREAS, A man of strong faith, Mr. Taylor was a longtime
17 congregant of Trinity Bible Church, where he served as a deacon and
18 was actively involved with the student ministry; he further gave of
19 his time and talents to the Weatherford ISD School Board, the
20 Weatherford Chamber of Commerce, the Christian Men's Fellowship of
21 Parker County, and Boy Scout Troop No. 109; and

22 WHEREAS, Above all else, Mr. Taylor was devoted to his
23 family; he took great pride in his sons, Riley and Colby, and he
24 enthusiastically supported them in their various school and

1 extracurricular activities; in his leisure hours, he cherished time
2 spent with his loved ones, playing games and going on camping trips
3 and other adventures; and

4 WHEREAS, Toby Taylor possessed a generosity of spirit that
5 expressed itself in myriad ways, and he enriched the lives of
6 countless people with his warmth and kindness; now, therefore, be

9 hereby pay tribute to the memory of Toby Leon Taylor and extend
10 sincere condolences to the members of his family: to his wife, Beth
