R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Fourth-grade students of St. Mark's School of Texas  
2 in Dallas are visiting the State Capitol on April 10, 2025,  
3 providing a fitting opportunity to recognize the school's rich  
4 history; and

5 WHEREAS, The campus traces its roots to 1906, when founder  
6 Menter B. Terrill and his wife, Ada, established The Terrill School  
7 for Boys; in 1946, the campus reopened as Cathedral School for Boys,  
8 and four years later, it merged with Texas Country Day School to  
9 form St. Mark's, a nonsectarian, college-preparatory, independent  
10 day school for boys in grades 1 through 12; and

11 WHEREAS, St. Mark's strives to provide students with  
12 well-rounded physical, intellectual, moral, and religious training  
13 and instruction; today, the school serves more than 900 students,  
14 and it offers challenging programs in the sciences, arts, and  
15 humanities, as well as a variety of opportunities for involvement  
16 and leadership on campus; and

17 WHEREAS, Over the past 119 years, St. Mark's has provided  
18 countless young Texans a strong academic foundation on which to  
19 build, and the school is indeed deserving of special recognition;  
20 now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the 89th Texas Legislature  
22 hereby honor the fourth-grade students of St. Mark's School of  
23 Texas on the occasion of their visit to the State Capitol and extend  
24 to them sincere best wishes for the future.
