R E S O L U T I O N

16 Little League baseball; and

17 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Hodges benefited from the  
18 love and support of his wife, Stevie, and he took great pride in  
19 their son, Wesley; above all, he cherished time spent with his  
20 family, especially traveling to the mountains and the beach and  
21 attending Dallas Mavericks games; his favorite leisure activities  
22 included hunting, snow skiing, and water skiing; and

23 WHEREAS, Cody Hodges led a life of caring devotion to his  
24 loved ones, and although he is deeply missed, his spirit will
