- 17 commercial lending officer and then vice president of Omaha

- 20 and Trust Company of Norman in Oklahoma; he took on his final role
- 21 as CEO and Regions Bank Texas Group president and moved to Tyler in
- 22 1993; at the time of his retirement in 2006, he was group president
- 23 of 81 locations across Texas; and
