WHEREAS, Family and friends were deeply saddened by the passing of James Edward Huston of Atlanta on April 6, 2025, at the age of 95; and

WHEREAS, The son of Para and Stinson Huston, Jim Huston was born on October 19, 1929, in Trinity and grew up sharing in the companionship of his three siblings, Betty Alice, Terry, and Peggy; he graduated from Trinity High School and continued his education at Stephen F.
