The Senate suspended the regular order, read third time and finally passed:

SB 10 **King/ Bettencourt/ Birdwell/
Campbell/ Creighton/ et al.**

Relating to the display of the Ten Commandments in public school classrooms.

SB 12 (CS) **Creighton/ et al.**

Relating to parental rights in public education, to certain public school requirements and prohibitions regarding instruction and diversity, equity, and inclusion duties, and to student clubs at public schools.

SB 13 (CS) **Paxton/ Bettencourt/ Birdwell/
Campbell/ Creighton/ et al.**

Relating to a school district's library materials and catalog, the creation of local school library advisory councils, and parental rights regarding public school library catalogs and access by the parent's child to library materials.

SB 17 (CS) **Kolkhorst/ Bettencourt/ Birdwell/
Campbell/ Creighton/ et al.**

Relating to the purchase or acquisition of real property by certain aliens or foreign entities.

SB 18 **Hughes/ Bettencourt/ Birdwell/
Campbell/ Creighton/ et al.**

Relating to prohibiting municipal libraries that host certain events from receiving state or other public funding.

SB 19 (CS) **Middleton/ Bettencourt/
Campbell/ Creighton/ Flores/
et al.**

Relating to the use by a political subdivision of public funds for lobbying and certain other activities.

SB 388 (CS) **King/ et al.**

Relating to the legislature's goals for electric generation capacity in this state.

SB 412 (CS) **Middleton/ et al.**

Relating to defenses to prosecution for certain offenses involving material or conduct that is obscene or otherwise harmful to children.

SB 495 **Sparks/ et al.**

Relating to the authority of the Texas Department of Insurance to adopt rules that implement or are based on certain environmental, social, and governance models, ratings, or standards.
