**IN RE: HB2500** by Spiller (Relating to certain proceedings by the Public Utility Commission of Texas regarding water or sewer service.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

There could be an impact on municipally owned utilities, counties, Water Supply/Sewer Service Corporations, or a district or authority related to temporary managers, receivers, and supervisors as the timeline for expedited review as shorten, as would be amended by the bill.
