IN RE: HB2701 by Guillen (Relating to construction standards for certain recreational vehicle parks and campgrounds.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require private recreational vehicle parks and campgrounds to comply with certain National Fire Protection Association standards, and would restrict the ability of governmental entities to impose more stringent standards.
