IN RE: HB2947 by McLaughlin (Relating to truancy; increasing a criminal penalty.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

It is assumed that any impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources would not be significant.

Local Government Impact

There may be costs to Local Education Agencies to submit the annual attendance report to the agency.

It is assumed that any fiscal impact to units of local government associated with enforcement, prosecution, supervision, or confinement would not be significant.
