IN RE: HB3482 by Troxclair (Relating to the authority of the Lower Colorado River Authority to issue permits for certain quarries and mines.), **As Introduced**

There could be an cost to the Lower Colorado River Authority related to performing a study on the environmental effect of a quarry or mine as would be outlined in the bill.
