IN RE: HB3621 by Bumgarner (Relating to certain disclosures and other requirements and prohibited conduct relating to the sale of tickets for concerts and other events.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Business and Commerce Code to add a chapter regulating the sale of event and concert tickets.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.
