IN RE: HB4129 by Davis, Aicha (Relating to the contract requirements for a contract between a single source continuum contractor and the Department of Family and Protective Services.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Department of Family and Protective Services to implement formal measures to ensure contractors provide high-quality services.

It is assumed that any costs to the Department of Family and Protective Services could be absorbed within existing resources.
