IN RE: HB4201 by Schatzline (relating to the locations where a handgun license holder may carry a handgun.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would remove certain locations from the offense of carrying a weapon in prohibited places.

It is assumed that any impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources would not be significant.
