IN RE: HB5394 by Rose (relating to prohibiting single source continuum contractors and child-placing agencies from imposing certain requirements on or adopting certain policies and procedures related to relative and designated caregivers.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would prohibit a single source continuum contractor or child placing agency from subjecting a relative or designated caregiver to any requirements not provided by law or department or Health and Human Services Commission rule.

It is assumed that any costs to the Department of Family and Protective Services could be absorbed within existing resources.
