IN RE: HB5560 by Harris (relating to penalties in certain suits involving a groundwater conservation district; increasing a penalty.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

There could be an impact on a groundwater conservation district if it assesses increased civil penalties as would be authorized by the bill.
