IN RE: HJR110 by Tepper (proposing a constitutional amendment requiring the filing of required political funding reports and personal financial statements to be eligible to hold certain public elective offices.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$191,689.

The bill would propose a constitutional amendment requiring the filing of required political funding reports and personal financial statements to be eligible to hold certain public elective offices.

According to the Texas Ethics Commission, no significant impact to the agency is anticipated relating to the joint resolution.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
