IN RE: SB570 by Bettencourt (Relating to an attendance policy adopted by public schools to prevent truancy.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

It is assumed that school districts and open-enrollment charter schools would be required to adopt and implement an attendance policy that adheres to the requirements of the Act; however, no significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
