IN RE: SB707 by King (Relating to the authority of the legislature to determine that certain federal directives are unconstitutional and to prohibit certain government officers and employees from enforcing or assisting in the enforcement of the directive.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

However, if the legislature were to prohibit certain government officers and employees from enforcing or assisting in the enforcement of a federal directive that the legislature determined to be unconstitutional, there could be an indeterminant fiscal impact related to any federal funding tied to that federal directive.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
