IN RE: SB1169 by Hinojosa, Adam (Relating to public utility agencies; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose assessments.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

There could be an impact on local governments as it gives public utility agencies the authority to issue bonds and impose an assessment to pay back the bond to acquire public utilities. The amount of the assessment is unknown.
