IN RE: SB1181 by Alvarado (Relating to the regulation of combative sports by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation; creating a criminal offense.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that any revenue implications associated with the bill would be insignificant.

It is assumed that any impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources would not be significant.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
