IN RE: SB2041 by Hancock (Relating to factors the Department of Family and Protective Services must consider when selecting a foster care placement for a child.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the factors the Department of Family and Protective Services shall consider in selecting a placement to include a placement that can meet the long-term needs of a child.

It is assumed that any costs to the Department of Family and Protective Services could be absorbed within existing resources.
