IN RE: SB2601 by Blanco (Relating to the landowner compensation program.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would modify eligibility requirements for the Landowners Compensation Program. The bill would also allow the Office of the Attorney General to request information from law enforcement agencies to aid with determining whether an applicant is qualified for compensation.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
