After all, raw milk is Nature's exclusive food for infants, so it must supply every single nutrient that the infant needs. Milk is an important source for nutrients like fat-soluble vitamin A, D, E and K2; vitamin C; all the B vitamins, especially vitamins B2, B6 and B12; and minerals like calcium, phosphorus and zinc as well as essential trace minerals. Levels of these vitamins will be higher if the cow is on pasture eating green grass. Moreover, raw milk supplies enzymes and carrier proteins to ensure that 100 percent of every nutrient is absorbed. Pasteurization destroys all these important co-factors. Milk that is processed, pasteurized, evaporated, centrifuged or otherwise tampered in some way, does not offer this miraculous all-in-one source for nutrients. See chart:

Vitamin C: Raw milk but not pasteurized can RESOLVE scurvy. "...Without doubt... the explosive increase in infantile scurvy during the latter part of the 19th century coincided with the advent of use of heated milks..."

Calcium: Longer and denser bones on raw milk.

Folate: Carrier protein inactivated during pasteurization.

Vitamin B12: Binding protein inactivated by pasteurization.

Vitamin B6: Animal studies indicate B6 poorly absorbed from pasteurized milk.

Vitamin A: Beta-lactoglobulin, a heat-sensitive protein in milk, increases intestinal absorption of vitamin A. Heat DEGRADES vitamin A.

Vitamin D: Present in milk bound to lactoglobulins, pasteurization cuts assimilation in half.

Iron: Lactoferrin, which contributes to iron assimilation, destroyed during pasteurization. Children on pasteurized milk tend to anemia.

Minerals: Bound to proteins such as calcium and iodine that are inactivated by pasteurization; Raw milk contains the bifidus factor, which encourage lactobacilli growth in the gut; lactobacilli enhance mineral absorption.

The push to impose permits and regulatory oversight on raw milk—such as proposed in HB1669—is an unnecessary and unjustified infringement on personal liberty, small farm autonomy, and consumer rights. Raw milk is a natural, traditional, and nutritionally rich food that humans have consumed for thousands of years without state interference. Requiring permits and creating bureaucratic hurdles only serves to criminalize small farmers, inflate costs, and restrict access to a product that many Texans actively and knowingly choose for its health benefits, digestibility, and unprocessed nature.

Let's be clear: this is not about safety. It is about control.

Raw milk consumers are among the most well-informed and intentional buyers in the food system. They don't need a state agency telling them what they can or cannot drink. These individuals are already aware of the nature of unpasteurized milk, often choosing it precisely because it hasn't been sterilized, denatured, or processed beyond recognition. - 2. Limit consumer access to trusted local sources, especially in rural and underserved areas.
- 3. Open the door to overreach, where future regulations can choke the raw milk market entirely under the guise of "public health."
- 4. Violate food freedom by treating raw milk like a dangerous contraband, instead of what it is: real, unadulterated milk that millions of people prefer for ethical, dietary, or medical reasons.

The reality is that raw milk, when responsibly produced by clean, well-managed farms, is as safe as any fresh food. No food is risk-free—yet we don't ban lettuce after E. coli outbreaks, nor do we require permits to grow carrots or raise chickens. Raw milk deserves the same respect and freedom. Permits and labels don't make food safe—education, transparency, and producer-consumer trust do.
