Relating to a study and report on burying power lines in the Gulf Coast region.

HB 1907 Paul | et al.
Relating to a prohibition on governmental contracts with Chinese companies for certain information and communications technology; authorizing a civil penalty; creating a criminal offense.

HB 2844 Landgraf
Relating to the regulation of mobile food vendors; requiring an occupational license; imposing fees; authorizing an administrative penalty.

HB 2892 Hernandez
Relating to the prohibited release by a public agency of personal affiliation information regarding the members, supporters, or volunteers of or donors to certain nonprofit organizations; creating a criminal offense.

HB 3439 Guillen
Relating to the powers and duties of the office of the attorney general with respect to certain laws governing the installation and use of tracking equipment and access to certain communications.

HB 3896 Raymond Posting Rule Suspended
Relating to the generation of electric power for sale by a water supply or sewer service corporation.

HB 4211 Noble | et al.
Relating to certain residential property interests controlled by certain entities.

HB 4536 Darby
Relating to notice submitted to state and local contractors of complaints alleging a violation of certain prevailing wage laws.

HB 5111 Darby
Relating to the regulation of campaign treasurer appointments and related matters and the content of and posting of information contained in a campaign treasurer appointment; providing a civil penalty.

HB 5138 Shaheen | et al.
Relating to the duty of the attorney general to prosecute criminal offenses prescribed by the election laws of this state.

HB 5182 Zwiener
Relating to civil penalties imposed by the Texas Ethics Commission, including the collection of and eligibility for public elective office of persons liable for those penalties.

HB 5247 Geren
Relating to alternative capital recovery process for certain utilities.

HB 5269 Barry
Relating to the authority of the Office of Public Utility Counsel to access certain data.

HB 5323 King
Relating to the creation of the Texas Energy Waste Advisory Committee.

HB 5435 Bell, Keith
Relating to required lease terms for public property leased to a nongovernmental entity.

HJR 201 Zwiener
Proposing a constitutional amendment requiring full payment of civil penalties imposed by the Texas Ethics Commission to be eligible to hold certain public elective offices.

SB 871 Birdwell | et al.
Relating to the authority of the legislature, governor, and certain political subdivisions with respect to disasters and emergencies.

SJR 40 Birdwell | et al. Posting Rule Suspended
Proposing a constitutional amendment regarding the powers of the governor, the legislature, and the supreme court following certain disaster or emergency declarations.
