18	SECTION 2. Section 51.9273, Education Code, as added by
19	this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the
20	effective date of this Act. A contract entered into before the
21	effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
22	date the contract was entered into, and the former law is continued
23	in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
