7	Sec. 38.0725. LIST OF PRIORITY FACILITIES. (a) In this
8	section, "priority facility" means:
9	(1) a facility listed in Section 38.072(b); or
10	(2) a facility for which electric service is
11	considered crucial for the protection or maintenance of public
12	safety, including:
13	(A) a hospital;
14	(B) a police station;
15	(C) a fire station;
16	(D) a critical water or wastewater facility; and
17	(E) a confinement facility operated by or under a
18	contract with any division of the Texas Department of Criminal
19	Justice.
20	(b) An electric utility shall maintain a list of priority
21	facilities in the utility's retail service area.
22	(c) An electric utility shall provide on the utility's
23	Internet website a mechanism for a facility to request that the
24	utility add the facility to the priority facility list. The

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- 1 electric utility shall add the requested facility to the list only
- 2 if the facility is a priority facility.
- 3 (d) On request from a facility, an electric utility shall
- 4 disclose to the facility not later than the 14th day after the date
- 5 the utility receives the request whether the facility is on the
- 6 priority facility list.
- 7 <u>(e) Notwithstanding any other law, on a declaration of a</u>
- 8 natural disaster or other emergency by the governor affecting the
- 9 service area of the electric utility, the utility shall provide the
- 10 list of priority facilities to the Texas Division of Emergency
- 11 Management.
- 12 (f) A priority facility list submitted to the Texas Division
- 13 of Emergency Management under this section is confidential and not
- 14 <u>subject to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code.</u>
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
