17	(2) if the permit was issued to the owner of the
18	facility, the person to whom the permit was issued no longer owns
19	the facility.
20	(c) If the commission cancels a permit under this section,
21	it may not approve a subsequent permit application for a municipal
22	solid waste landfill facility that was the subject of the cancelled
23	permit.
