(a) This section applies to a school district or open-enrollment charter school that discontinued 10 participation in the program effective on September 1, 2022, in 11 12 accordance with Section 1579.155(a). 13 (b) Notwithstanding Section 1579.155(b), a school district or charter school to which this section applies may elect to 14 participate in the program before the fifth anniversary of the 15 effective date of the district's or school's election to 16 discontinue participation in the program if the district or school: 17 18 (1) provides written notice to the trustee not later than December 31, 2025, of the district's or school's election to 19 20 participate in the program effective beginning September 1, 2026; 21 and 22 (2) complies with any other requirements established 23 by the trustee for program participation. 24 (c) For the plan year beginning September 1, 2026, the

21	(c) For the plan year beginning September 1, 2026, the
22	trustee shall impose a risk stabilization fee in an amount
